In the Treasurer's absence the report was tabled by the secretary.

General Business:

- Tony Groube asked why Secretary was tabling Secretaries report in new format Peter advised that the figures used were accurate but just put into a spreadsheet and confirmed by President R Fish.
- Brian Perkins raised about the Bunning BBQ notification in the last newsletter and that there was no phone number provided to contact.
- Tony Groube advised that the Guest speaker had not been advertised in the newsletter.
- Rob Fish advised our guest speaker for this month had withdrawn and that Gordon Marion had agreed at short notice to speak to us about how he grows his orchids.
- Tony Groube also advised that if we advertised the guest speakers then we may get more members to attend the meetings.
- Dot Kauffman requested to purchase more bark 10mm nuggets.
- 'It was then discussed that Dot should be able to order bark on behalf of Grumpy's Shed as needed up to \$1200 but will need to advise committee prior to order so as it can be recorded.
- Dot also requested a stock take of Grumpy's Shed stock.
- Dot also requested that she may need to get some pots also from Garden City Plastics.
- Rob Fish advised Village centre promotion day is coming up as well as the Winter Show more info in next Newsletter.

- There is a possible need to purchase Cymbidiums for the sales Table (no more than \$1000).
- Brian Perkins asked if there were any of the leftover plants from last year in flower Rob advised 4.
- Tony Groube also advised that as he and Liz are currently downsizing they could have about 10 to 20 plants.
- Tony Groube also commented that in his opinion the plants purchased last year were not in top condition and that they did a disservice to the club in regard to quality.
- It was decided that we do not purchase addition plants for the sales table from external suppliers.
- Rob Fish advised where do we buy plants from if we need to be better Quality.
- Dorothy Kaufman advised that we have always relied on members to provide plants for the sales table.
- Ron Boyd advised that he agrees with Tony as he sold some of Cymbidiums last year and he said that some of the plants were pot bound and were in need of repotting and that some had fungus on them.
- Ron Boyd then proposed a motion that members can purchase their own tables to sell plants at club shows. After discussion Ron then moved the motion for approval.
- Moved Ron Boyd seconded Liz Cleaver
- After a show of hands the motion was accepted 12 for the motion 4 against (therefore motion was carried).
- The cost of the table will be \$50 (confirmed)per table for the duration of the show.
- There is a requirement that members request tables prior to the show.
- Ron then requested 3 tables for the Winter and Spring shows.
- Brian Perkins asked about the Batehaven Garden and Hardware centre as they provide monthly gift vouchers if we can consider reducing cost to them and Rob Fish advised that as they are a club sponsor we waiver any costs associated with table hire.
- Brian Coulton advised that anybody wishing to sell plants needs to consider attaching a photo to assist the buyers and that Ron uses this method to assist in selling his orchids.
- Rob Fish advised that we need to purchase plants for raffle and prize plants. After discussion it was agreed to purchase plants in 80mm pots as these are more advanced than 50mmm tube stock and better value for the newer members.
- He will order from Tinonee Orchids.

We then had a Supper Break at 8.30pm

After Supper we were lucky that Gordon Marion was able to fill in after our guest speaker was not able to attend.


Gordon's talk was on how he grows his orchids, Growing media and feeding.

Gordon uses a mix of Perlite, Rock wool and Styrene of equal amounts. He showed us a sieve that he made up years ago. He uses old styrene fruit boxes that he runs through the sieve to make into usable size to add to the mix (Gordon advises to stay away from the packaging that you get with TVs and other household items as he believes that may contain chemicals that may be harmful to your orchids).

Gordon also advised that you should always follow appropriate safety precautions when using these products (secretaries comment a mask is essential as well as good ventilation). Also Gordon went through his fertilizer mixes which he uses and showed some plants to demonstrate his results. All the products used can be purchased from Bishop's at South Nowra.


