<u>Treasurer's Report:</u> Treasurer Margaret Turner read out the monthly financial statement and made copies available for members. Treasurer Margaret Turner Moved they be accepted, Seconded: Tony Groube

General Business

- **No. 1:** President Robert Fish read out his President's report for 2013, attached copy at end of newsletter.
- **No. 2:** President Robert Fish welcomed two new members, Brian Coulton & Anne-Marie Collins and presented them with a bag of goodies.
