**Growing tip!** When finishing your re-potting of orchids into new pots and all the old pots have a white powder around the bottom of the pot, sometimes that is hard to remove, despite a good soak! Try adding a strong dose of vinegar to the water and leave for 4-5 days, then rinse off with a hose spray. Pots usually come up bright and clean. I use about 1 lt. of vinegar (cheap no brand for about \$1) to about 50lt of water. Do not add bleach at this stage as the vinegar will chemically react with the bleach and both become ineffective!


