Presidents Report – April 2018

Welcome all members to our **April Monday** 2nd club meeting.

For those members and visitors who attended the March 5th club meeting where Mr. Gerry Walsh, world leading expert grower and breeder of the famous Golden Yellow Dendrobium - speciosum var. grandiflorum. He gave a great and interesting talk on his adventures over the years, going up to sunny Queensland around the steep rocky mountain tops area searching for the speciosum var. grandiflora. All I could say was 'WOW' to see huge clumps of grandiflora with their Golden Yellow flowers in the wild.

From the rate his plants were bought from the sales table, I would expect to see some top quality golden flowers in a few years.

I love to listen to guest speakers, as you can pick up quite a few great ways of improving the way you grow your orchids. The main tips that I picked up from Gerry's talk on growing these grandiflora, was from most of the slides that we saw, were of plants growing on steep rocky cliffs or atop massive boulders, in full very hot sunlight all day. From this, I grow all mine under 30% shade cloth, allowing maximum sunlight with just a small amount of protection from the harsh summer sunlight. Open free draining potting mix was another idea when you see these plants growing on the side of steep cliff, their roots anchoring the plants in cracks and small crevices.
